**I**N Haiti with the on-going food crisis, people are hungry and are seeking help and during their search, many end up coming to our churches. During this crisis, we are finding that people are not only hungry for food, but there is an increased hunger for spiritual things as well. Our Pastors in Haiti report that each week as people come to receive food staples that we try to keep on hand, they are accepting Christ also. After they receive Christ and are given some teaching, they are then baptized. Our churches in Haiti are all filled to capacity. We tried to hold 2 morning services to accommodate the people in Nepley, however in Haiti's culture that was not successful because everyone then wanted to attend both services. They don't want to miss anything because they are so hungry spiritually. So, in order for everyone to go to church, our Pastors often have to send new Christians to churches in other villages in the Leogane region.

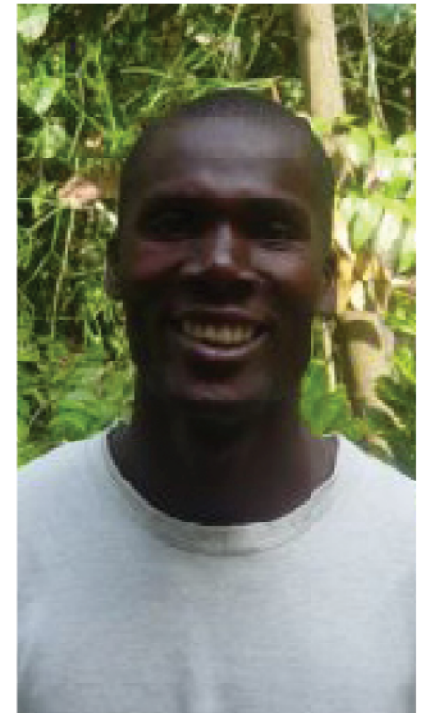

Besides providing education for the 600 plus students who attend our 2 primary schools in Flace L'or and Santo, we often try to give assistance to youth who have a dream to further their education. The 3 young men on the church committee in the Rum Village have never been able to finish their education. One of them named Wilson had come to me two years ago following a Sunday morning service, with tears streaming down his face telling me that he had a dream to finish school but his family was barely able to find enough food let alone pay for an education. I told him to begin to pray and God has answered that prayer and this September not only Wilson, but all 3 young men will be enrolled in school. Another young man in the village of Nepley has been asking us for a long time if we could possibly help him go to Trade School as this has been his dream. Joclet is a new Christian and I have been telling him to pray that God opens the door for him. Recently, his prayer was also answered and we will be enrolling him in a 3 year program in September. There are 18 others that we are also giving extra educational assistance to that could not otherwise go to school this fall.
