Our New Clinic Facility in Neply

This year started with the excitement of me flying into Haiti with my son Joe and a team of Canadian men to receive our first container full of 90 shelters to be assembled for Haitian people to live in! We were only supposed to receive 20 shelters but God gave us a miracle of 90, PLUS a container to keep for future use!

The Canadian men worked alongside our Haitians teaching the assembly of 45 shelters and the balance of them were shared with

another organization whose families also had housing needs. Our second mission team returned from Haiti March 2nd! They spent the week ministering words of encouragement and hope accompanied by Humanitarian Aid!! It was also a week full of fun, games and playful times with the Haitian people! Following a year of so much devastation and pain in 2010, it was uplifting to see so many smiling faces and hear laughter in every village we visited!

The New Permanent Church in the Rum Village is completed. It was wonderful to finally have our Grand

Opening and Dedication Services on Sunday February 27th. The church was packed and people had to stand outside! When we first started working in this village in 2004 it was barren and poverty stricken! We started small and today it's not only us working there, but 3 other organizations have joined in the efforts since the earthquake! With so much unity the people now have a Church Sanctuary, Clean Water, Feeding Programs, Micro-loans to make families self supportive, a New Orphanage is being built to care for 60 children and Wood Homes with metal roofs have replaced stick shacks! It's being completely transformed!

Construction of our New Clinic in Neply is also finished! It is a beautiful and spacious facility that is helping us serve more people in our area! We do need more equipment, furnishings and supplies for each room.

We are continuing to see progress one step at a time in Haiti! There is always a need for more help because of the extreme situations in people's lives, but it's a thrill every day to see something new accomplished and another life given hope!
