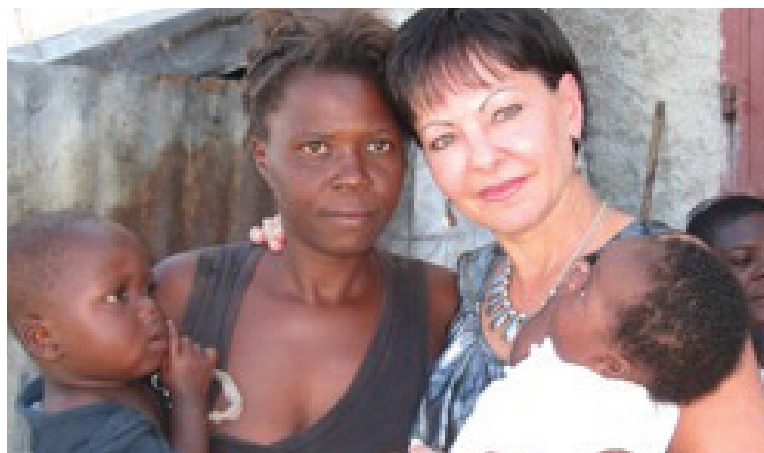


MERRY CHRISTMAS FROM HAITI
