

Johnny Boy is doing well and is being cared for by a young couple we've chosen from the village of Neply. Recently we located Johnny Boy's Mom who originally abandoned him because she is so young and had no way to care for him. She is now living in the village of Neply with a family who has taken her in and she attends our Neply church. She spends each afternoon with Johnny Boy and we are hoping to help give her a new start in life so she can eventually be able to care for Johnny Boy.

Madame Bolo is now living with her daughter and a new home is being built for them in the village of Birey. Since we've been helping them with their needs, Madame Bolo has actually gained weight and looks much stronger than when we first met her in November 2006. During my visit to her home in December she was telling me how happy she is to be living with her daughter who bathes her every day and combs her hair and prepares food for her. Madame Bolo looks so happy and so much healthier and she is full of hope and gives the glory to God for the help she's received this year!



Since finding Murille and Mijeline in May living in extreme poverty, God has enabled us to completely turn their lives around. They are now receiving a good education at our Santo School and we are currently building them a new 2 room cement home which will be finished by the end of January. We are also furnishing the home with beds so they don't have to sleep on the floor. This family has also been given goats and chickens which help them with food. We've helped their mom buy baskets so she can sell cherries at the market but right now their family is still receiving extra monthly financial help until they can make it on their own.



Our Santo Orphanage Family is growing and this year we've taken in more children. With the children growing up the monthly needs are increasing in this area but God has been providing and we are very excited for the future of these children who once had no hope. We are so pleased to announce that in January we are planning to begin construction on the new facility to house these children. The property we've purchased is beautiful and full of fruit trees with room to play. It is within walking distance to school and church. There will be an area for the girls and an area for the boys separated by a large dining room and kitchen. This will be a long awaited dream come true for these children and the orphanage staff.
