Haiti Crusade 2009

From August 13 to August 16th we held our first large crusade in Haiti. Over the past years we have done crusades however because we also fed the people, the numbers who could attend were controlled. This crusade was opened up to anyone who wanted to come even beyond our own villages and it was a crusade where rather than feed the people, we asked them to fast and pray for the island of Haiti. We had a wonderful turnout of people who came all the way from the outskirts of Port au Prince. The original site for the crusade was going to be on the land at the nursing home property but because of torrential rains, we had to move the services to the Nepley Church to protect sound equipment and instruments. Although we were able to protect all of the equipment, the church was far too small to hold the thousands of people, so tarps were strung from trees outside and chairs set up. Every side of the church, out in the field and down the road on both sides was completely packed with people as

well as the inside of the church and the balcony upstairs. During the day, people fasted and prayed. Thirty-two people from Port au Prince area slept on the Nepley Church floor for the entire time and prayed around the clock for the services and for their country. People were saved and set free!! We saw so many miracles and people delivered from evil spirits in front of our eyes. The crusade was such a success that we already have plans to rent a stadium in Haiti next year and do it on a much larger scale and reach out to more people. The services were broadcasted on the Haitian Radio Station and we are getting a lot of feedback from people that they want to attend the next crusade and bring their friends too. We hope to in the near future send out a few video clips of the crusade to those of you who are supporting the ministry. We are claiming, "Haiti for Jesus!!!"
