Neply is the base village for our Mission work. Without the Faithful workers we have from this village, many of our other programs and ministries would not be happening today. Neply is our strongest village with the most mature Christians who have been taught well and have learned how to reach out to others as we enable them. They continue to send Haitian prayer teams and ministry teams to our other villages and churches to teach them what they have been trained to do as disciples. Since the earthquake, we have seen even more spiritual growth in Neply and many new people have accepted Christ including 3 voodoo priests from the area.

Our former church in Neply was damaged so the part that is safe enough to enter is being used to hold our food supplies. A new temporary building has been erected which not only acts as a church but a community center to run many programs out of and holds approximately 2000 people.

This temporary building will not last forever but will suffice until we can raise enough funds to build a permanent structure on the land. A security wall is being built around the property, public toilets and an artesian well was drilled where people come to get clean water.



We are thrilled that the rebuilding in Haiti has started! To see things moving ahead has given the people in our villages so much hope again for their future. We are currently building in 3 villages which gives our families jobs and hot meals daily when they are involved helping with our projects. Many schools were completely damaged during the earthquake, so it is important that we put a focus on education so children can continue going to school. In the village of Ti-Brache the first phase of a new Primary School is under construction. Many families of the children who will go to this school are involved

in the building project. The Haitian men are hired to build and the women are hired to cook hot food for the work teams. It is important to keep the Haitian people busy which aids in the healing process from the loss they have suffered in their lives. On May 12th the drilling rig came on site to start drilling a new well in Nepli. Fortunately they went deep enough to find artesian water which is a never ending supply of clean water—now we can pipe it to the Homeless Shelter and Future nursing home properties where those 2 wells were destroyed in the earthquake. We are also drilling a well in the village of Ti-Brache for the people there.
