This week, workers are busy putting up shelters to use for church services. The women are busy caring for the needs of the children and also keeping hot food ready for the men and youth who are doing the building. These shelters will only be temporary to protect the people from the hot sun and rain, but it is important that when the aftershocks are completely finished, we will need to repair damaged buildings and reconstruct new ones that have been destroyed as quickly as possible so that the mission work can continue on for the people. (These temporary shelters will not be strong enough to withstand hurricanes.) How fast we can do everything that needs to be done will depend on the donations that are available for us to work with. Even during the rebuilding stages we will have to continue to assist many people with food and medical help.

The task in front of us looks absolutely overwhelming and at times “impossible” but we stand in Faith believing that.....”With God, all things are possible!” Again, I want to mention we couldn’t do this without your help and we sincerely appreciate all who have given already!!
