Framework for Temporary Housing Structures

This morning our Haitian workers were able to find another 10,000 pounds of rice to distribute plus spaghetti to villages in our area near Leogane. The US Marines are also distributing meal replacement drinks and continue to bring injured people to be treated at our Nepley Clinic.

Pastor Antoine located lumber, some tools and heavy plastic so today our men are all busy working on building temporary shelters for the people. Each shelter will have a wood frame, plastic roof and cloth walls and will house 20 -30 people in each.

Every day they start with a 4:00 am prayer service and everyone seems to be working together in unity to help each other survive each new day! At 6:00pm each evening another prayer meeting is held until about 8:00 and then everyone goes to bed for the night.

We continue to see people dedicate their lives to Christ!! Without your financial support, we would not be able to offer hope to these people!!
