The new school building in Ti-Brache is coming along well but there is still a lot of work to do before the grand opening in September. The school will be open from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm for Primary Grades and then will re-open from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm for high school grades plus Computer and Computer repair, Music, English and Bible Theology Classes. We plan to offer more Trades in the future as we can. People in the village had a celebration and time of thanks for the newly drilled well and the church continues to flourish and expand.

In the village of Flonc (The Rum Village) we have finished rebuilding the security wall around the property and a temporary church is set up until we can start the new permanent building. In a recent rainstorm, the tarp roof was torn off and so we had to do more repairs a second time. In the area, another organization has opened an orphanage for children and that will be their entire focus. During my last trip I was able to visit with the children and help with some needed supplies. These children will also attend our village church. Its awesome when people can work together to build Gods Kingdom and care for His children!!

For each of our building projects, we use all Haitian people to give them employment. Along with the construction crews, we also hire Haitian women to cook a hot meal each day. In doing this they have a way to support their families and rebuild their own lives. An engineer is on site to oversee all work being done.

Through our 4 National Churches and Clinic, we are continuing to distribute food weekly to people in need. Although we can't help everyone in Haiti, we are trying to do our part. God is the one who makes it possible for us reach out to thousands of people each year through your financial support and prayers.
