With the amount of villages and projects we are involved with, last year we saw there was a need to register the properties in Haiti with the Haitian Government. To do this you need to find a lawyer in Haiti that you can trust and it is a costly and lengthy process which is why some organizations hesitate to proceed in doing so. We made this a matter of prayer and this past year God sent us a wonderful lawyer who donated

much of his time to help us with all of the paperwork involved. In November we were so pleased to receive our mission license from the Haitian Government under the name of Love Haiti Missions! This gives us added protection and possibly some new open doors for the mission work in Haiti!!

In our country we often take food for granted and it is estimated that on average, people in Canada and the USA throw away \$1200.00 worth of groceries each year. God has truly blessed us not for our own gain but to be a blessing to others who have very little or even nothing. In Haiti if you take a village walk and do home visitation, it is very common to discover that there is not even one food item in that home. Rice is very expensive for the Haitian people who often live on less than \$1.00 a day but it is filling and their most favourite food when beans are added for protein. With the desperate poverty that the people face in Haiti, it doesn't take much to put a smile on their faces. One bag with 2 momits of rice and beans added will touch a heart more than we could ever comprehend. Children love spaghetti so this is often given out as well at

our children's programs. This past year we have reached out to more than 10 villages, the congregations of our 5 churches, our school children and those who visit our clinic by giving them dry food staples. Over the Christmas season we will be giving extra help to as many as possible plus each of our churches will be handing out a hot nutritious meal at Christmas to those who would otherwise have absolutely nothing! Sometimes at Christmas it's easy for us to forget the true meaning of the season. Christmas is our opportunity to show the world what the Compassion of Christ is about.....it's a time to give hope and a time to spread "joy!"
